

AMENDMENT 2
to the 2008-2009 Annual Update to the Consolidated Plan

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (the "Act") allocated funds to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to assist local communities with the economic recovery.

This one-time allocation authorized in the Act provides Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to enable local governments to undertake a wide range of activities intended to create suitable living environments, provide decent affordable housing and create economic opportunities, primarily for persons of low and moderate income and with an emphasis on job creation and economic development opportunities.

The Act also provides a one-time allocation of The Homelessness Prevention Fund to provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized.
