On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval with conditions* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to allow structural and aerial encroachments for "Fountains at Germantown" comprised of a skybridge encroaching above Alley #201, a stoop and upper balconies encroaching above Taylor Street and awning/canopies and upper level balconies and signage encroaching along Third Avenue North on properties located at 1401 and 1403 Third Avenue North, 1408 and 1410 Fourth Avenue North and at 302 Taylor Street, zoned Specific Plan and located within the Phillips-Jackson Street Redevelopment District and the Germantown Historic Preservation District, requested by Civil Site Design Group, applicant; Fountains Germantown Holdings LLC., owner.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.

Conditions that apply to this approval:

Historic Zoning: Per Robin Zeigler, Historic Zoning Administrator: The project is located within the Germantown Historic Preservation Zoning Overlay District. The facades and all appurtenances shall be approved by the MHZC.

Encroachment Approval Process in Public Right-of-Way

The following information is for aerial, underground and building encroachments. Aerial encroachments require a resolution approved by the Metropolitan Council. Underground and building encroachments require approval by ordinance (three readings before the Metropolitan Council). Attached are the following items concerning the encroachment approval process for your use.

- 1. License Agreement for private encroachment
- 2. Sample insurance form
- 3. Petition to encroach upon a public right-of-way

Your firm should submit the following information:

- A. A letter of request to Mark Macy, Director of Engineering of Public Works.
- B. Engineering details: showing exact location of encroachment, design, measurements of sign, and anchoring details.
- C. Signed License Agreement.
- D. Insurance forms: minimum requirements, at least \$50,000 in case of injury to one person, \$100,000 in case of injuries to more than one person, and property damage insurance of at least \$5,000 each accident, \$10,000 aggregate.
- E. Processing fee of \$250.

Public Works will review and submit the application to the Metropolitan Planning Commission, this process normally takes 60 to 90 days. Upon approval by the Metropolitan Planning Commission and the Metropolitan Council an application must be made with Metropolitan Codes Administration, if applicable. A permit will be required to be taken out with Public Works by the contractor to perform the installation of the approved encroachment.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

This is to further certify to the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County concerning the policies of insurance listed above and the coverage provided thereby that:

- 1. The Contractual Insurance coverage is on a Blanket Broad Form basis unless specifically indicated below,
- 2. The company or companies, upon request, agree to deliver within fifteen (15) days a certified copy of any and/or all of the policies of insurance to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County,

LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR PRIVATE ENCROACHMENTS INTO THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

I/We Fountains Germanton Hdd Mgs, LLC in consideration of the Resolution No. _ construct, maintain, install and/or operate an encroachment into, onto, over, or under the public right of way located at in Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee, do hereby, for myself, my agents, customers, and assigns, waive and release and hold harmless The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, its agents, employees, and assigns from any and all claims, rights, or demands for damages that may arise from my/our use, construction and/or maintenance of the encroachment, to wit: (SEE ATTACHED DESCRIPTION OF ENCROACHMENT). I/We hereby certify to the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that I/We have executed a bond or liability insurance policy in such amount as agreed upon by the Director of Public Works and the Metropolitan Attorney, and in the form approved by the Metropolitan Attorney (per Metropolitan Code Section 38-1-1), which operates to indemnify and save The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County harmless from all claims or demands that may result to persons or property by reason of the construction, operations or maintenance of the encroachment. I/We further agree that my/our obligations hereunder may not be assigned except upon approval of the Director of Public Works and the Metropolitan Attorney. I/We further acknowledge that any action that results in a failure to maintain said bond or liability insurance for the protection of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County shall operate to the granting of a lien to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County in the amount of the last effective bond/insurance policy. Said insurance or bond may not be cancelable or expirable except on 30 days notice to the Director of Public Works.

I/We further recognize that the license granted hereby is revocable by The Metropolitan Government upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and approval by resolution of the Metropolitan County Council if it is determined to be necessary to the public welfare and convenience. In the event the Metropolitan Government revokes this license as contemplated by this paragraph, licensee will not be entitled to any compensation of any kind. This license shall also be strictly subject to the right of way easement owned by The Metropolitan Government. I/We agree to maintain, construct and use the encroachment in such a way as will not interfere with the rights and duties of the Metropolitan Government

as owner of the right of way. Said interference shall be additional grounds for revocation of the license for encroachment. I/We agree to pay the cost of construction, maintenance, use, as well as relocations cost of said encroachment. Licensee's failure to complete construction of the contemplated encroachment within 36 months of the date of approval by the Metropolitan Council will cause this license to terminate automatically. In the event the encroachment contemplated by this license is substantially destroyed, this license shall terminate unless fully restored by licensee within 36 months from the date of such destruction. In the event this license is revoked or terminated for any reason, licensee shall restore all public property to the condition obtaining at the time the license became effective at licensee's sole cost and expense. 

Mandatory Referral Application

If any electrical vaults are located below proposed sign, awning or fiber optic cable, special design standards may be required. Contact Larry Cantrell at NES 615-747-3964 for more information on electrical vault locations.

DO NOT INSTALL anything that would encroach over Metro right-of-way until your application is approved by Metro Council. If you do, you could have to wait six months before your application is considered by Metro Council. For more information, see Council Bill BL2000-444 available at <u>http://www.nashville.org/mc/ordinances/bl2000_444</u> or call the Metro Clerk for a copy of the bill at 862-6770.

Filing Fee \$250 (All application fees are non-refundable)

Notarized Signature of Property Owner(s)

You must obtain the *notarized* signature of all property owners whose property the sign or awning will occur. Failure to provide this information will deem your application *incomplete* and postpone your application's consideration by the Metropolitan Planning Commission.

Franchise License

If fiber optic cable company, prior to submitting a fiber optic cable encroachment, you must contact John Kennedy of Metro Legal at 615-862-6341 for determination of whether franchise license is required.

Certificate of Liability Insurance

Certificate must identify Metro Government of Nashville & Davidson County as Certificate Holder.

Right-of-Way Notice

While not a requirement of your application, please be aware that no construction work may be undertaken in any street, road, afley or right-of-way or of any utility or temporary construction easement of the metropolitan government or other government entity by any department of the metropolitan government or any other entity unless adequate notice has been given to the abutting fee owner of a street, road, alley, or right-of-way or fee owner of the easement, and to the district member of council representing the area of such construction work.
